

## Installation guide for Linux

If the installation of VP Bank e-banking does not work with the following instructions, please perform the installation in a terminal window.

Hint: Please make sure that the latest Java version 1.8 is installed.

1. Open the [www.vpbank.com/e-banking](http://www.vpbank.com/e-banking) website. On the «Downloads & Tools» menu, click on «e-banking version for Linux».
2. A dialogue box will appear. Save the file «e-banking-en.tar.gz» on your computer.
3. Extract the downloaded file. The file «e-banking-en.tar» will appear.
4. Extract the file «e-banking-en.tar». The folder «vpbank-ebanking» will appear. (In some Linux distributions, you have to rename the file to «e-banking-en.tar»)
5. Open the folder «vpbank-ebanking» and run the file «e-banking install» by double clicking. The installation will be performed.
6. Start VP Bank e-banking via the link on your Desktop.
7. You can now login to e-banking.

### Installation in a terminal window

Hint: Please make sure that the latest Java version 1.8 is installed.

1. Open the [www.vpbank.com/e-banking](http://www.vpbank.com/e-banking) website. On the «Downloads & Tools» menu, click on «e-banking version for Linux».
2. Start the terminal window and change into the directory, where the download file is located. Use the following commands:  

```
gzip -d e-banking-en.tar.gz
tar -xvf e-banking-en.tar
cd vpbank-ebanking
./install.sh
```
3. Start VP Bank e-banking via the link on your Desktop.
4. You can now login to e-banking.
